We wish to share with you some information in an effort to answer several questions that have been brought forth.

District policies and regulations are all listed on our school website under the "District" then "Board of Education" tab. The Harassment, Intimidation or Bullying (HIB) policy is #5512. Most school policies are mandated by the State.

The School Choice Program is a NJ State Program that allows students from other school districts to attend Central Regional. There are several schools in Ocean County that offer the School Choice Program. This is a very competitive program since the State only allows us approximately 89 spots for students. The primary criterion for being accepted for School Choice is high academic achievement so we accept students with good academic records from their previous home districts. The School Choice Program has nothing to do with homelessness situations and it is not used for parents to transfer students because of any former disciplinary issues from their home schools.






